



DIEGO MASTRANGELO was born in Capital Federal, Buenos Aires.

In 1994 he started taking Tango lessons at Escuela Municipal de Danzas “Jose Neglia” of Moron.

He studied for a year with Aurelio & Delma, teachers that have lived the golden period of tango in Argentina.

He then went on to study with Osvaldo Coelho, well-known for his unique elegant style of Tango. He studied with him for 3 years, and became his assistant.

In 1999 he started to study the Cosmotango Style, with Fabian Salas & Gustavo Naveira (from the Sally Potter’s film “The Tango Lesson”).

He has also taken lessons with Mariano “Chicho” Frumboli & Lucia Mazer, as well as with renowned performer

He has taken part as an assistant in the Cosmotango Congresses (CITA 1999/2000/2001).

Between April and June 2001 he performed all around Greece (Athens, Volos, Larissa, Thessaloniki, Kabala, Lamia, Peloponese, Pilio and Crete).

During 2002 he was given the main role at the tango advertising of Gioconda Chocolates.

He presented an original research paper based on the way tango dance has changed in the last years at the 17th Congress on Dance Research which was held in Naxos Island from 22 to 26 of October 2003.
